WARNING! discontinuity in functions (**n/c** suffixes at the end of the tags) is not mentioned in the guidelines. **n** suffix stands for the head (the finite (.Fn) or non-finite (.NFn) clause) receiving the complement; while **c** suffix stands for the complement (the dislocated function of a finite (.Fc) or non-finite (.NFc) clause). In sentences with two cases of discontinuity, the second one holds the suffix **2**, both in the head and the complement.

.NFn: means that the constituent is a non-finite clause, one of whose complements is dislocated .Fn: means that the constituent is a finite clause, one of whose complements is dislocated .NFc: means that this complement is dislocated from its non-finite clause .Fc: means that this complement is dislocated from its finite clause
