Ticket is mandatory (get them at registration).

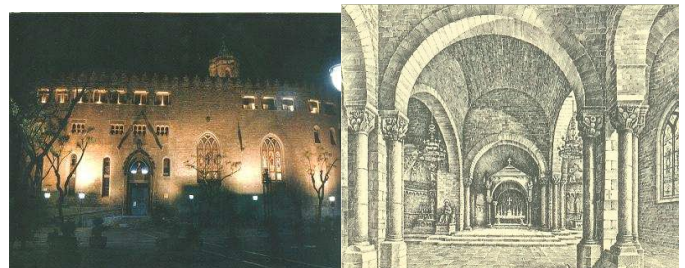

How to arrive to Sant Pere de les Puel·les:

Metro: L1 (red), *Urquinaona* and *Arc de Triomf*

Bus: 19, 39, 40, 41, 42, 55, 141, *Ronda Snt Pere*

Suggested path from UPC: Take Metro L3 (green line) at *Palau Reial* (direction to Canyelles). Change at *Espanya* (7 min) and take Metro L1 (red line; direction to Fondo). Get off at *Urquinaona* (6 min) and walk (5 min).

How to arrive to La Casa Llotja de Mar:

Metro: Line 4 (yellow line), *Jaume I* and *Barceloneta* station

Bus: 17, 36, 40, 45, 51, 57, 59, 64 and 157, *Pla de Palau*

Suggested path from UPC: Take Metro L3 (green line) at *Palau Reial* (direction to Canyelles). Get off at *Drassanes* (7 min). Walk to *Passeig Colom*. Take Bus 64 (direction to *Barceloneta*). Get off at *Pla de Palau* (3 stops) and walk (2 min).
